

## **Biography for Marcus B. Schaefer**

Mr. Schaefer has served as President/CEO of Truliant FCU (formerly AT&T Family FCU) in Winston-Salem, North Carolina for eleven years. At the forefront of the banker lawsuits against NCUA and credit unions, Marc has addressed hundreds of credit union CEOs and volunteers, met with dozens of Congressional Representatives, Senators and staffers and educated members of the media on the critical role that credit unions play in society.



Truliant FCU is known for its innovative use of technology to enhance member service including video kiosks, touch screen kiosks, home banking and smart cards.

Mr. Schaefer played a key role in management's deploying these technologies to improve member access and relationships.

He served previously as CEO of FDIC Employees FCU for nine years and as Controller of U.S. Postal Service FCU for four years.

Marc is currently serving as Chairman of the National Association of Community Credit Unions and Chairman of the National Credit Union Roundtable. He is also Vice Chairman of the Credit Union National Association's Federal Credit Union Subcommittee. He is a member of the Government Affairs Committee of the North Carolina Credit Union Network and the Members Development Company Board of Directors.

In Forsyth County, Mr. Schaefer serves on the Winston-Salem Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors and the Governmental Affairs Executive Committee. He chairs the Fiscal Policy and Regulatory Affairs Subcommittee for the Chamber. He also serves on the Downtown Winston Salem Partnership Board of Directors.

Mr. Schaefer has served on a variety of Boards and Committees including the National Association of Federal Credit Unions, the Filene Research Council, the Commission on Savings and Investment in America, the Encore Cooperative, National Council of Postal Credit Unions and the CUNA Mutual Bond Study Committee.

He has provided the World Council of Credit Unions with technical assistance to credit unions in Costa Rica, Guatemala, Bolivia, Suriname, Ecuador and Mexico.

Mr. Schaefer is a recipient of the North Carolina League's Professional of the Year Award. He has also received the World Council of Credit Unions' Silver Award and was named a founding member of the International Executive Volunteer Corps.

He holds a Master of Management from the American Graduate School of International Management and a BA in Political Science from UCLA.
