High Point credit union robbed

HIGH POINT — A man with a gun robbed the Truliant Federal Credit Union on Wednesday.

High Point police said the man entered the bank at 4006 Mendenhall Oaks Parkway at 9:11 a.m. Wednesday. He took an undisclosed amount of money, then drove off in an older-model sedan toward Premier Drive. No injuries were reported.

Police described the suspect as a black man about 6 feet tall who wore a black hooded sweatshirt, blue jeans, white tennis shoes, a black face mask and white rubber or cloth gloves. His car is a dark blue or forest green Chevrolet Caprice or Oldsmobile with tinted windows and large chrome rims. Police said the car's color appears to change in the light.
